to land &c., on the Labrador or North Shore of the River and Gulf of St Lawrence.

have the right have, use, and enjoy the freedom of taking bait and of fishing in any and every River, Creek, Harbour, or Road, with liberty to go on shore on any waste and unoccupied part or parts of the Labrador or North Shore of the River and Gulf of St. Lawrence, and upon any Island or 5 Islands contiguous thereto, from Pointe des Monts, eastwardly to the easternmost limits of the Province on the Gulf Shore or Labrador, for the purpose of trying Whale or Seal Blubber, and rendering it into oil, salting, curing, and drying fish there, to cut wood for making and repair- 10 ing stages, flakes, hurdles, cook rooms and other purposes necessary for preparing their oil and fish for exportation, or that may be useful to their fishing trade, without hindrance, interruption, denial or molestation from any person or persons whomsoever.
