An Act to incorporate the Canadian Bankers' Association.

WHEREAS the voluntary association now existing under Preamble the name of the Canadian Bankers' Association has, by its petition, prayed that it may be enacted as hereinafter set forth, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said 5 petition: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows :--

1. There is hereby created and constituted a corporation Incorporaunder the name of "The Canadian Bankers' Association," here-10 inafter called "the Association."

2. The Association shall consist of members and associates; Association,

(a.) The members, hereinafter referred to as members, shall composed. be the banks named in the schedule to this Act, and such Members. new banks hereafter incorporated by or under the authority 15 of the Parliament of Canada as become entitled to carry on the business of banking in Canada, and to which The Bank Act in force at the time of its incorporation may apply. bank to which The Bank Act applies, carrying on business in Canada, and not named in the schedule to this Act, shall on 20 its own application at any time be admitted as a member of the Association by resolution of the Executive Council hereinafter named:

- (b.) The associates, hereinafter referred to as associates, shall Associates. be the bank officers who are associates of the voluntary associa-25 tion mentioned in the preamble at the time this Act is passed, and such other officers of the banks which are members of the Association as may be elected at a meeting of the Executive Council hereinafter named or at an annual meeting of the Association. An associate may at any time by written notice 30 to the president of the Association withdraw from the Association.
- 3. Upon the suspension of payment of a bank being a Effect of bank member of the Association, such bank shall cease to be a suspending. Provided however, that if and when such bank 35 resumes the carrying on of its business in Canada it shall again become a member of the Association.

4. Upon an associate ceasing to be an officer of a bank When carrying on business in Canada, he shall, at the end of the then associate ceases to be current calendar year, cease to be an associate.
