C A P. XXVIII.

An Act to permit the Inhabitants of *Fersey* and *Guernsey* to export directly from thence to *Newfoundland*, or the *British* Colonies in *America*, Goods necessary for the Fishery, under certain Restrictions; and to import from thence Non-enumerated Goods (except Rum) and to land the same in the said Islands.



WHEREAS by an Act made in the Fifteenth Year of the Reign of His late Majesty King Charles the Second, intituled, An Act for the Encouragement of Trade, it is, amongst other Things, enacted, That no Commodity of the Growth, Production, or Manu-
