With Doug Smith of the Athletics sitting out a penalty, Keegan scored his first of three goals to tie the score at 2-2. Paul Henderson received an assist on this one.

A little more than half a minute later, Brian Aherne put the Sailors one up with a pretty goal. He beat How in the St. Catharines net while fighting off a check from one of the Athletic defencemen.

That wound up the scoring in the first period despite the fact that St. Catharines picked up three penalties in a row before the period ended. The third penalty, to Brian Thompson, did prove costly in the early part of the second period, however, as Keegan scored from Henderson and Kowalski at the 1:17 mark which was just 20 seconds before Thompson stepped out of the penalty box.

Finally, at the 16:17 mark, Flori Tomchyschen stole the ball from St. Kitts and broke out for the other end. He passed to Aherne who was speeding in from the side and Brian made no mistake with his low shot. That made the score read 5-2 for the Sailors at the end of the second period.

Just past the halfway mark of the period Peter Berge scored the Athletic to move them to within one of the Sailors. Port Credit was not to be denied in this one, however. Julie Kowalski, who played a strong game throughout, finally clicked after taking a pass from Brian Aherne.

Keegan wound up the scoring for the night with just 30 seconds left to play. Tomchyschen was credited with an assist on this tally.

The Sailors play a return game with the Athletics, in St. Catharines tonight (Wednesday, June 30) and then play host to the Peterboro Speedy Erns the following night at the Port Credit Arena.
