I have to direct your attention to letter to you of the IIth October last, pointing out that the \$42.27 paid by Lydia M. Booth to you -, on account of Lot 29, Block C. Deseronto, should be included in and Return and forwarded to the Department, and have to state that as the money has been received, but was not included in your Return for October last, you will be good enough to forward a special Return for that month, showing this payment under date 4th October, 1909, Principal \$32, 15 and Interest \$10, 12. As this is necessary to avoid confusion in the accounts, you will kindly lose no time in forwarding this Special Return, and in Duplicate.
