Sir :-

I beg to inform you that as Dr. J. F. McAulay, who has held the position of Medical Attendant on the Indians of Malagawatch, has moved from the vicinity of the Reserve, it has been decided that the medical treatment of the Indians of that place be given to you at a salary of \$75.00 per annum, which will cover services, medicine and all expenses.

You will be expected to enter upon your duties at once and to respond to all reasonable calls of the Indians.
