Referring to your letter of the 8th instant, I beg to state that you are authorized to purchase the horse asked for in your estimates for 1916-1917 for use of the Farmer on Poorman's Reserve.

In view of the representations made you are also authorized to purchase a driving horse for your use to replace the one that is not fit for your work, and which you propose to transfer to one of the Farmers.

The cost of these horses should not exceed \$175.00 in each case, if possible, and you will please report to what farm your driver will be transferred.
