



Sir,

With reference to your letter of the 26th instant, in regard to the loan of \$100.00 to Ephraim Marsden, No. 129 of the Alnwick Band to enable him to buy a mare, I beg to say that the said loan is approved, upon the understanding that his interest shares and rent money will be retained to repay the loan.
