OBLIQUE INGUINAL TRUSSES.

entirely new. An uniform pressure throughout the
whole extent of the pad is thus obtained; and the spring,
acting as a universal joint, allows the girdle to adapt itself
to the varying movements of the body without disturbing
the pad.
