

C A P. III.

An ACT in Addition to, and Amendment of an Act for continuing the ſeveral Laws relating to the Duties on licenced Houſes, and for the Appropriation of the Monies raiſed thereby.

*E*t it Enacted by the Governor, Council and Aſſembly, That from and after the 31ſt Day of December, 1784, the
B Clerks or Receivers of the Licence Duties in each County within this Province, ſhall return a juſt Account every half Year to the Juſtices of the General Seſſion of each County or Diſtrict, except the Town or Diſtrict of *Halifax*, of the Monies ſo by him or them collected, and ſhall pay the ſame half yearly into the Hands of the County Treasuſer; And in Caſe ſuch Receiver or Receivers ſhall neglect or reſuſe to render ſuch Accounts and pay in ſuch Monies as aforeſaid, he or they ſhall forfeit for each & every Offence the Sum of *Twenty Pounds*, to be recovered by the Judgment of ſuch Seſſions, and applied to the Purpoſe of Repairing Roads within ſuch County, and the ſaid Juſtices by and with the Advice of the Grand Jury for ſuch County are hereby empowered to lay out, and expend ſuch Monies for Repairs of Roads and Bridges within their reſpective Counties and Diſtricts, and to account with, and receive from the ſaid Clerks or Receivers all Monies now remaining due for Licences heretofore obtained, which have not been paid into the Treasuſry of this Province, and in Caſe ſuch Receiver or Receivers ſhall neglect or reſuſe to render ſuch Accounts and pay ſuch Monies, he or they ſhall forfeit and pay the Sum of *Twenty Pounds* for each and every Refuſal or Neglect, to be recovered and applied as aforeſaid,

II. And be it further Enacted; That the Receiver of the Licence Duties within the Town and Diſtrict of *Halifax*, ſhall account with the Treasuſry of the Province half yearly, and ſhall pay into the Treasuſry all ſuch Monies as he ſhall receive, which Monies ſhall be applied to and for the Purpoſe of making and repairing Roads within Ten Miles of ſaid Town of *Halifax*; the ſame to be laid out and expended under the Direction of the Governor, Lieutenant Governor or Commander in Chief for the Time being, and that this Act, and alſo an Act paſſed in the Eighth Year of his Maſteſty's Reign, intituled, "An Act for Suppreſſing unlicenced Houſes and for Granting to his Maſteſty a Duty on Perſons hereafter to be licenced," except ſuch Part thereof as is hereby before altered and amended, ſhall be and remain in full Force to the Thirty Firſt Day of December, in the Year of our Lord One Thouſand Seven Hundred and Eighty-five.

Clerks or Receivers of duties in County (*Halifax* excepted) to return Account half Yearly to the Seſſion of the County and pay the Money collected to the Treasuſrer of ſuch County.

On Penalty of £20. to be applied for repair the Roads &c. of ſuch County.

Juſtices with Grand Jury empowered to expend ſuch Monies for Repairs of Road &c. now remaining due for Licences hereto obtained.

Receiver of Licences duties at *Halifax* to Account with the Treasuſry half Yearly. And Monies paid therein to be applied on the Roads therein to be applied on the Roads & within Ten Miles of *Halifax*.

Act to continue to December 31ſt 1785
