## WOMAN'S EFFORT TO TAKE OWN LIFE UNSUCCESSFUL

Made Suicidal Jump Over High Bridge At St. John

## BUT WAS RESCUED

Only Person To Escape Death in Such A Case

St. John, N.B., July 1.—In an unsuccessful attempt to commit suicide Mrs. Harold Climo, of this city, Monday performed a feat that last year proved too much for the nerve of daredevil Rodman Law, the aviator and athlete, who has defied death so often for the moving pictures.

Mrs. Climo jumped from the C.P.R. suspension bridge over the reversing falls at the mouth of the St. John River, dropping 100 feet to the swirling waters below, and was picked up alive, although unconscious.

### Only One To Escape

As far as known she is the only person who has ever made the jump and escaped the death penalty. Last

year Rodman Law and his wife, Mabel Boulton, planned a similar feat for the benefit of the moving pictures, but after a close study of the place decided not to make the attempt.

Mrs. Climo, who is the wife of a leading photographer and occupies a prominent position in society is about fifty years of age and mother of a large family. She has been prominent in various public affairs and is one of the leaders in the woman's suffrage movement here. No cause for her rash act is known, although there is evidence that she has been planning it for several days.

### Dress Helped Her

Walking out about a hundred feet Mrs. Climo paused on the brink, and then made the plunge feet first. Her silk dress ballooned out, and acting like a parachute, somewhat broke the force of the fall, but the shock of striking the water rendered her unconscious.

Mrs. Climo was carried ashore to a neighbors house, a doctor summoned, and after first aid measures, was rushed to the hospital, where she is recovering the effects of her startling experience, and apparently little the worse for it.

## RESCUE SHIPS TO GET \$70,000 FOR 'CAIRNHILL'

Steamer Broken Down And She Was Abandoned

## LUCKY STEAMERS

Long Tow Yet Ahead Of The Rescued Ship


As intimated in a recent issue of the Shipping Gazette, the long drift of the steamer Cairnhill has been brought to an end by her being towed safely into Namatania, in 3 39 S., 152 25 E. It is reported that nothing in the way of effecting repairs to the broken-down vessel can be carried out at New Guinea, and it is understood that arrangements are being made for towing the vessel to Sydney, N.S.W. The steamer, which has her shaft broken close to the stern tube, has been arrested, but arrangements are being made for her release. The strs. which towed the ship in are the Mek-long and Star. It was on March 31st that the Cair-

hill, while on passage from the Ocean Island for Stettin, broke down. About a week later all her crew with the exception of the captain, second officer, first and fourth engineers, and the steward, left the vessel in three boats. These got separated in a gale, but after a series of exciting and trying adventures, during which they suffered a good deal from exposure and privation, the crews of all three eventually met at the island of Rabaul in the Bismarck Archipelago, whence they got passage on a steamer to Sydney.

Attempts were made to effect repairs by those on board. The chief engineer improvised some rough paddle wheels, which he geared up to the engines, but the ship was uncontrollable. It was after this that the bulk of the crew decided to leave the drifting ship.

The Cairnhill will prove a fine salvage for the towing steamers, as her value, including the phosphate cargo, is stated to be about \$70,000.00.
