Shots were exchanged between the revolutionists and the Obregon forces during the advance. A strong garrison of forces of President Obregon is located at Oriental

As at the formal inquiry held at St. John into the stranding of that ship near Briar Isand in the Bay of Fundy on Oct. 25 when the vessel suffered serious damage, it was not within the province of the court to deal with the masters certificate, a copy of the findings will be forwarded to the Norwegian government to deal with it as it sees fit.
