The side of the mountain is broken by numerous corries and crags, which, softened by distance, are blended with the surrounding herbage, and Coir-nan-Orisken,

At the west end of Loch Katrine, we take coach again for 5 miles, through Glen Arklet to Invermaid to Lock Lomond. At Invermaid is a pretty water-tall and over it a slender foot bridge, the scene of Wordsworth's "Highland Girl."

From here a most beautiful view of Loch Lomond is obtained. The north portion of it is narrow and hemmed in by lofty mountains. At this point is the entrance to Glenfallech, and the commencement of the ronte through Glencoe to Ballachulish, which traverses some of the wildest scenery in Scotland. At Tarbet is the landing place for those who wish to cross the ithemus to Arrochar and Lock Long. About a mile from Invermaid is Rob Roy's Cave, and near by as the steamer skirts the mountain may be seen an arch-shaped cavern, named Rob's prison. Soon the "lofty brow of Ben Lomond" looms in sight, from the top of which a majestic view is obtained. From point to point as the boat threads its way among

This trip can easily be made in one day, and at a very moderate cost.


