1st	Trees, Nursery trees and seeds.
2nd	Barrilla or bar and carbonate of soda impure.
3rd	Clay, in bricks and tiles, also lime, Whiting, Gypsum, and every kind of stone for building.
4th	Fresh beef coming from the home country on national vessels.
5th	Mineral and bituminous coal and charcoal.
6th	Hind or bark to tan leather.
7th	Leather straps and all sorts of military equipments manufactured in Spain.
8th	Ases, mires, horses, mules, as also all kind of woolly and stock cattle imported to improve the breed.
9th	Guan and all sorts of natural and artificial manure.
10th	Machines and mechanical apparatus of all kinds imported for agricultural purposes, that is to say, machines whose tendency be to make less costly the working of country properties and the saving of hands.
