TH OTHER MARKETS SLIGHTLY WEAKER THE MORNING SESSION WITH SHOWED DECLINES. - ON REPORT STRIKES TORONTO STOCK BREAKS 31 POINTS .- CONSOLS THE SAME, C. P. R. LOWER 1 IN LONDON.

Montreal, Feb. 26.

The 1 point decline of Pacific to 98 # on the local market was the same as the decline in London. All openings of American stocks there were lower than the opening of the previous day. Other features were noticeable, the decline of Montreal Street for instance which at 2803 was 21 points lower than what it closed at on Friday. These noticeable as instances of general dullness were less conspicious than the selling in Toronto, which carried prices down some 31 points. On the report of a strike among the Company's employees, the opening of the stock to-day was I lower than previous close and the following sales were each on a lower level till the final concluded with 99g.
