## BRADSTREET'S REPORT OF STOCKS

Total stocks in the United States and Canada, east of the Rocky Mountains, as reported by Bradstreet's June 28, were 2,643,000 bushels, as against 2,047,000 bushels, the previous week.

Total stocks in the United States and Canada a year ago were 2,317,000 bushels, according to Bradstreet's report.

Stocks of wheat at Pacific coast ports on June 21 were 255,000 bushels.

## THE VISIBLE SUPPLY.

The Chicago visible supply statement of stocks in the United States and Canada, east of the Rocky Mountains, for the week ending July 5, was 62,000 bushels, being an increase of 62,000 bushels for the week. A year ago the visible supply was 59,000 bushels, two years ago 54,400 bushels, three years ago 53,400 bushels, four years ago 52,300 bushels, five years ago 50,000 bushels.

## STOCKS OF OATS AND CORN.

The visible supply of oats in the United States and Canada, east of the Rocky Mountains, is 1,481,000 bushels, compared with 1,180,000 bushels a year before. The visible supply of corn is 5,912,000 bushels, compared with 14,720,000 bushels a year ago, according to the Chicago statement.

## GRAIN STOCKS AT LAKE PORTS.

## Port William.

Stocks in grain in C. P. R. elevators at Port William on Monday, the 7th July, were as follows:

Wheat—1 hard, 206,250 bushels; No. 1 northern, 519,908 bushels; No. 2 northern, 305,987 bushels; No. 1 northern, 3,709 bushels; other grades, 17,177 bushels; making the total of wheat 1,030,222 bushels.

Oats—No. 2 white, 39,993 bushels; barley—No. 2, 33 bushels.

Receipts of wheat at Port William during the week amounted to 259,551 bushels, and shipments to 280,944 bushels.

## Port Arthur.

Stocks in store at King's elevator, Port Arthur, the 7th July were:

Wheat—No. 1 northern, 339 bushels; No. 2 northern, 142 bushels; other grades, 81,629 bushels; total, 82,101 bushels.

Oats—No. 2 white, 1,942 bushels; mixed, 2,210 bushels; total, 4,152 bushels.

Receipts of wheat at this elevator during the week were 25,712 bushels, and shipments, 42,936 bushels.

Stocks of grain in store at the Canadian Northern elevator at Port Arthur on the 7th July were as follows:

Wheat—No. 1 hard, 46,559 bushels; No. 1 northern, 24,075 bushels; No. 2 northern, 72,589 bushels; No. 3 northern, 1,651 bushels; making a total of 145,344 bushels.

Oats—Feed, white, 8,999 bushels.

Receipts of wheat for the week, 75,639 bushels; shipped during the week 49,753 bushels.

## Manitoba Wheat Stocks.

There were 1,317,796 bushels of wheat in store at Port William and Port Arthur on July 5. A year ago stocks in store at Port William were 1,080,000 bushels, and two years ago 1,618,000 bushels. Stocks in store at Port William, Port Arthur, Keewatin, Winnipeg and interior points are estimated approximately at 3,000,000 bushels, compared with 2,482,000 bushels a year ago, 3,625,000 bushels two years ago, 5,550,000 bushels three years ago, and 1,200,000 bushels four years ago.
