- 3. It is also proposed that:
- (a) in relation to route 1 in section I of the said Schedule to the Agreement signed at Ottawa on the 19th August, 1949*, as amended in accordance with the proposal in paragraph 2 of this Note, services between Vancouver and the United Kingdom and between Edmonton and the United Kingdom must call at one other traffic point in Canada, except by prior agreement between the aeronautical authorities and
 - (b) the terms set out in the Exchange of Notes, dated 18th August, 1958*, shall have effect in relation to the Schedule to the said Agreement, as amended in accordance with the proposal in paragraph 2 of this Note, as it has effect in relation to the Schedule to the said Agreement at the date of this Note, except that the restriction of rights on route 1 of section I between points in the United Kingdom, on the one hand, and Dusseldorf, on the other, to stopover rights shall no longer be applicable applicable.
- 4. If the Government of Canada are prepared to accept the foregoing terms, I have the honour to suggest that this Note and your reply to that effect shall constitute an Agreement between the two Governments in regard to these matters which shall be deemed to have taken effect on March 1st, 1960.
