CRNBERRA (CP) - External Affairs Minister Joe Clark said today at the opening of a Commonhealth foreign ministers meeting that a report recommending tougher sanctions against South Africa is

THE REPORTS COMMISSIONED BY THE COMMONHEALTH COMMITTEE OF FOREIGN HINISTERS ON SOUTHERN AFRICA AT ITS LAST MEETING IN FEBRUARY IN HARARES ZIMBABHES ALSO QUESTIONED WHETHER CANADA HAS DOING ENOUGH TO FIGHT APARTHEID IN SOUTH AFRICA.
