His Excellency Taieb Slim today presented his Letter of Credence as Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Tunisia to Canada.

The ceremony took place at Government House at 11.00 a.m. Mr. Henry F. Davis, Chief of Protocol, Department of External Affairs, presented the Ambassador to His Excellency the Governor-General. Mr. Ross Campbell, Assistant Under-Secretary of State for External Affairs, and Mr. Esmond Butler, Secretary to the Governor-General, were in attendance on the Governor-General on this occasion.

Mr. Taieb Slim is a brother of Mr. Mongi Slim (the first Tunisian Ambassador to Canada). Before his present assignment he was Ambassador in London with concurrent accreditation to Sweden, Norway and Denmark. He will continue to serve concurrently as Ambassador and Permanent Representative of Tunisia to the United Nations.
