## NOTICES OF MOTIONS.

For Wednesday, 30th September, 1896.

By the Honourable Mr. McClelan :—

1896.

- 1 September 28—That an humble Address be presented to His Excellency the Governor General ; praying that His Excellency will cause to be laid before the Senate, copies of all correspondence or other papers, in the possession of the Government or any department thereof, in any way relating to the dismissal of the following officials in the County of Albert, New Brunswick :—
1. Captain Joseph McAlmon, harbour master for the port of Harvey, dismissed in 1884.
  2. John R. Stiles, keeper of Grindstone Island light and fog alarm station, dismissed in 1885.
  3. James E. Kinnie, fishery warden, dismissed in 1887.
  4. William S. Sturratt, keeper of Cape Enragé light and fog alarm station, dismissed in 1888.

By the Honourable Mr. Ferguson :—

- 2 September 23—That he will call the attention of the Senate to the extraordinary announcement of policy made by members of the Administration regarding the Civil Service of Canada, and to the recent unjustifiable dismissals of public employees ; and that he will inquire of the Leader of the Senate what the policy of the Government is on these subjects ?
