all of which would help to develop their economic sense. Association of this kind, too, would give them a foothold in the
business world by means of which they could more easily establish
themselves.

In the strictly vocational work, the present two year
Diploma Course seems very sound provision. It affords an opportunity to farm boys and others who contemplate farming to gain
some preparation for their life's work. Many splendid fellows
are being helped in this way, and, while the course in its
present form has been offered for only five years, boys who have
taken it and returned to the farm are already demonstrating its
advantages. A third year is now being offered to a limited
number who indicate special capacity for directive work in one
or more branches of farm practice. The suggestion is made
that this course can be still further strengthened by adding
business training features. This could very well be done
through the Economics Department were the staff in a position
to undertake the teaching.

In the whole field of teaching, therefore, the opportunity for even greater service is apparent. Since teaching must continue as a major function of the College, the Committee would submit that teaching ability should receive equal recognition with that of research capacity in determining the value of members of the staff.

Special Considerations - While still on the subject of students, two thoughts suggest themselves to the Committee, one dealing with the securing of student material, the other with standards of attainment.
