

R U L E S

OF

THE MONTREAL LIBRARY.

I.—The Library will be open from Eleven o'clock, A. M. till Four o'clock, P. M. every day, Sundays and Holidays excepted.

II.—The Library is solely appropriated to the use of the proprietors and Subscribers; and no others are admitted, except non-resident strangers, introduced by Subscribers.

III.—Any Proprietor or Subscriber may take out of the Library, and retain,

One Folio, Ten days.

One Quarto,..... Eight days.

Two Octavos, or smaller Volumes,... Six days.

IV.—No Subscriber to have more than *one* new book at a time, nor to keep it longer than *four* days; if a quarto, not beyond a week.

V.—Any person failing to return a book on the day appointed, is subject to a fine of five pence for each running day until it be returned or paid for; and is also, until then, deprived of the use of the Library; and the Librarian has particular orders to enforce this law.
