

PLACE-NAMES

- kâkpesegakun*, French River; abounding in smelts.
- kalebovâkade*, Caribou Marsh; caribou place.
- kalebootcwâkade*, brook near Liverpool; little caribou place.
- kaloogel*, Carraget Harbour.
- kamsôk*, Canso; opposite the lofty cliffs.
- kamsôkootc*, Little Canso; little place opposite cliffs.
- kamsôkoolcêtc*, White Head, C. B.; little place opposite small cliffs.
- kapskwekook*, (local application); the waterfall.
- kaskamkek*, Cascumpec, P. E. I.; a bold sandy shore.
- kabâk*, (*kebek*), The Narrows; (1) above Halifax; (2) below Milton; (3) Quebec; a possible origin for the name Quebec.
- kedoooskek*, Second Lake on Liverpool River; surrounded by tall grass.
- keganagwetck*, Inganish, C. B.
- kekskakskith*, Crawford's Falls; the sandy shore.
- kenomê*, Economy; a long point jutting far out to sea.
- kentoogwasik*, ; the largest river.
- keseboogwak*, place between Richebucto and Miramichi; coming together in narrow places.
- kesegwilck*, Moose River, near Parrsboro.
- kespoogwilck*, Land's End, Yarmouth; (2) Cape Negro.
- kesooskiboogwek*, River Philip; flowing through hemlock.
- kesooskiboogwasê*, Little Hemlock River.
- kesooskorwoostooogwek*, Middle River.
- ketadoosoke*, a river flowing into the St. Lawrence.
- kewtuminêgê*, St. Paul's Island.
- kiktiseboogwek*, Lennox Island, P. E. I.; (2) Island near Mer-rigomish; a small passage.
- kiktceboogwek*, (kijeboogwek), Bay View, P. E. I.; I encircle around it, enclose it.
- kiktceboogwek booktâbâ*, New London Bay, P. E. I.; great bay of nets. (enclosures.)
- kinobenkek*, Big Bank.
- kitpoâkade*, Eagle Point or Cape Shubenacadie.
- klooskeâkade*, Cloopsky Point; awk-land.
- koobetawâekwêmode*, Beaver Harbour; tradition relates that Glooscap threw one of the large rocks there at the mythical beaver.
- koobulkwijook*,
- koogumijenawânak*, Cape Dolphin.
- kooiksoomoosigek*, Thorn Point; the thorn grove.
- koojumkoojik*, Fourth Lake on Liverpool River; attempting to escape.
- kookujook*, Blue Mountains, Yar. Co.; giant's home.
- kookwejokwâdê*, Middle River, Sheet Harbour; haunt of the giants.
