<i>kākpēsegakun</i> , French River;	<i>kesooskiboogwek</i> , River Philip; flowing through hemlock.
<i>kalebovākade</i> , Caribou Marsh;	<i>kesooskiboogwasēs</i> , Little Hemlock River.
<i>kalebootcwākade</i> , brook near Liverpool; little caribou place.	<i>kesooskowostooogwek</i> , Middle River.
<i>kalooget</i> , Carragat Harbour.	<i>ketadoosoke</i> , a river flowing into the St. Lawrence.
<i>kamsōk</i> , Canso; opposite the lofty cliffs.	<i>kewtuminēgē</i> , St. Paul's Island.
<i>kamsōkōolc</i> , Little Canso; little place opposite cliffs.	<i>kiktceboogwek</i> , Lennox Island, P. E. I.; (2) Island near Merrigomish; a small passage.
<i>kamsōkōolcēt</i> , White Head, C. B.; little place opposite small cliffs.	<i>kiklceboogwek</i> , (<i>kijebōogwek</i>), Bay View, P. E. I.; I encircle around it, enclose it.
<i>kapskwehook</i> , (local application); the waterfall.	<i>kiktceboogwek booktābā</i> , New London Bay, P. E. I.; great bay of nets, (enclosures.)
<i>kaskamkek</i> , Cascumpec, P. E. I.; a bold sandy shore.	<i>kinobenkek</i> , Big Bank.
<i>kabāk</i> , (<i>kebek</i>), The Narrows; (1) above Halifax; (2) below Milton; (3) Quebec; a possible origin for the name Quebec.	<i>kitpoākade</i> , Eagle Point or Cape Shubenacadie.
<i>kedooskek</i> , Second Lake on Liverpool River; surrounded by tall grass.	<i>kloopskeākade</i> , Cloopsy Point; awk-land.
<i>keganagwetck</i> , Inganish, C. B.	<i>koobetawāēākwēmode</i> , Beaver Harbour; tradition relates that Glooscap threw one of the large rocks there at the mythical beaver.
<i>kekssakskitk</i> , Crawford's Falls; the sandy shore.	<i>koobulkwijook</i> ,
<i>kenomē</i> , Economy; a long point jutting far out to sea.	<i>koogumiñenawānāk</i> , Cape Dolphin.
<i>kenloogwasik</i> , ; the largest river.	<i>kooksoomoosigek</i> , Thorn Point; the thorn grove.
<i>kesēboogwak</i> , place between Richebucto and Miramichi; coming together in narrow places.	<i>koojumkoojik</i> , Fourth Lake on Liverpool River; attempting to escape.
<i>kesegwitck</i> , Moose River, near Parrsboro.	<i>kookujook</i> , Blue Mountains, Yar. Co.; giant's home.
<i>kespoogwitck</i> , Land's End, Yarmouth; (2) Cape Negro.	<i>kookwejokwādē</i> , Middle River, Sheet Harbour; haunt of the giants.
