THE SENATE OF CANADA.

BILL RR.

An Act respecting The Brockville, Westport and North-western Railway Company.

WHEREAS the Brockville, Westport and North-western Railway Company has by its petition prayed that it be enacted as hereinafter set forth, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition: Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

1. The Brockville, Westport and North-western Railway Company may complete its railway and put it in operation within five years after the passing of this Act; and if the said railway is not completed and put in operation, within the said period, the powers of construction conferred upon the said company by Parliament shall cease and be null and void as respects such portion of the said railway as then remains uncompleted.
