

- (4.) Plant those varieties that are most resistant.
- (5.) Cut out the disease as it appears so far as possible and practical. Always make clean cuts.
- (6.) Cut out every sign of disease in the dormant season.
- (7.) Disinfect tools and cut surfaces.
- (8.) Paint all large wounds.
- (9.) Use a ladder; do not climb trees.
- (10.) Gather and burn all prunings.
