Your Committee beg to report as follows:-

1. That the memorial of Victoria District, asking that permission be given the trustees of Pandora Avenue Church, Victoria, B.C., to sell the parsonage property, No. 107 Quadra Street, the proceeds to be applied to the purchase of other property and the erection of a new parsonage, be granted.

2. From the same District, asking that permission be given to the trustees of the Nanaimo Methodist church to sell to the corporation of the city of Nanaimo a right of way through the church property, for purposes of street extension, the proceeds to be applied to general church

purposes. Request granted.

3. In the case of the memorial from Victoria District, in reference to the Maple Bay church property, requesting that permission be given the trustees to sell that portion of the church property east of the graveyard, containing fifty acres, more or less, with the exception of any and all mineral rights. Such sale to be made in consultation with the Chairman of the District, and proceeds to be applied toward the building of a new church. Resolved that permission be not granted.

4. Re memorial from Westminster District, asking that a Conference

evangelist be appointed. Action deferred for the present.

5. Re memorial from Kamloops District, asking that permission be given to Rev. T. W. Hall to take up collections and subscriptions throughout the Conference during the year for the relief of the Kamloops church property. We recommend that the request be granted.
