 But you have scattered firebrands be-  
 tween them. You have endeavoured to  
 ripen tumult to anarchy, and dissatis-  
 faction to rebellion; and to transform  
 punishment into waste and extirpa-  
 tion.

The tumour of your stile, the info-  
 lence of your manners, your rawness in  
 the great principles of the subject which  
 you treat, and your universal inaccuracy,  
 or unfairness in arguing, are inferior con-  
 siderations and faults that may be for-  
 given. But let it be remembered at all  
 events, that with respect to this point  
 you confess, that if the Americans are  
 right, it is robbery in us, not rebellion  
 in them. Now I ask any man, whether  
 on this state it is so clear that America  
 is wrong, and that it is not robbery in  
 us, as that we should lightly run the  
 risque of becoming murderers also; and  
 murderers of our fellow-subjects into the  
 bargain?
