has commanded high prices in the home markets. There is a model creamery and cheese factory at Finch and a model creamery at Brome.

- Butter. While a considerable quantity of hntter is manufactured on the farm, the number of creameries, especially in the large centres of population is rapidly increasing. 30,289,028 pounds of butter, valued at \$13,630,063, were manufactured in Ontario by 172 creameries during 1918. 4 recent development is the making of whey butter.
- **Cheese.** Ontario produces more than haif the cheese manufactured in Canada, and exports in large quantities to Great Britain. The output of 970 Ontario cheese factories for 1918 was 107,886,724 ibs., valued at \$24,-356,019.
- Condensed Milk. There are 16 factories manufacturing condensed milk.
- POWDERED MILE. This industry is advancing in Western Ontario., There are now 4 factories which have absorbed several cheese factories.

- FLAX. In 1915, Ontarlo had 4,000 acres in flax; in 1916, 5,200; in 1917, 7,372; in 1918, 15,925; in 1919, 13,717 acres. Following the visit of Commissioners from the War Office in 1918 to procure flax for the British aeropianes the Provincial Government acquired idle land near Toronto to cuitivate flaz for demonstration purposes.
- Linssed Oil. There are iarge oil mills in Western Ontario, the flax seed being obtained from the Prairie Provinces. The quantity of oil produced varies from 15,900 to 20,000 barreis yearly, all marketed in the Dominion.
- Linen and Fibre Manufacture. 33 fax milis are operated, and 1 inen mili at Guelph. Other milis are being equipped with linen machinery. With the development of new methods and machinery the industry promises to become permanent. Ontario water retted flax is considered equal to the best Irish.
