The above original “Justin Morgan” Horse, from whom all descended, was sired by “True Briton,” or “Beautiful Bay,” he kept in New Jersey. The “True Briton” was owned by General Mifflin while operating on Long Island, during the Revolutionary War, and was of the “Wild Air” breed, sired by “Diamond,” a colt of “Wild Air” of the same name.
