

MAY FORCE RAILWAY TO PROVIDE PROTECTION

Series of Fatal Accidents at Hamilton Station—Shunting of Cars a Menace.

HAMILTON, Sept. 6.—(Special.)—Oswald Gage, 13-year-old son of Mrs. M. Gage, a widow, 876 Main-street east, was crushed to death by a freight car in the local Grand Trunk yards shortly after 12 o'clock last night.

His brother and a number of other passengers narrowly escaped injury. An inquest into the boy's death will be held by Coroner McNichol next Tuesday evening.

Last night's fatal accident will probably have the effect of prompting the railway company to provide proper protection for passengers using the Grand Trunk yards.
