PEACE ON EARTH FAVORITE THEME IN CHURCHES ON SUNDAY; CHRISTMAS MUSIC RENDERED BY THE CHOIRS

First Peace Christmas for Four Years Brings Many Returned Soldiers to Worship, Some Maimed and Shell-Shocked, But All Cheerful and Thankful War Has Ended.

"Peace on Earth, Goodwill to Men" was the theme taken by the majority of the ministers of the city yesterday. Christmas Sunday was generally observed throughout the churches of the city, and along with the Christmas sermons special music appropriate to the day was rendered by all the choirs assisted by various talented soloists. For the first Christmas since the year of 1913, the angel of peace has spread his wings over the battle-scarred fields of Belgium, France and Flanders. Hundreds of London boys who one year ago, were in the trenches, have returned to their families, and others are on their way home. These facts no doubt helped to make the services of the day more realistic. Mingled with the throngs of worshippers one could see young men in khaki, some who had lost one arm, or a leg, others shell-shocked, who had been invalided home before the armistice had been signed. These, judging by their looks, enjoyed the various anthems as much, if not more than any others present at the service.

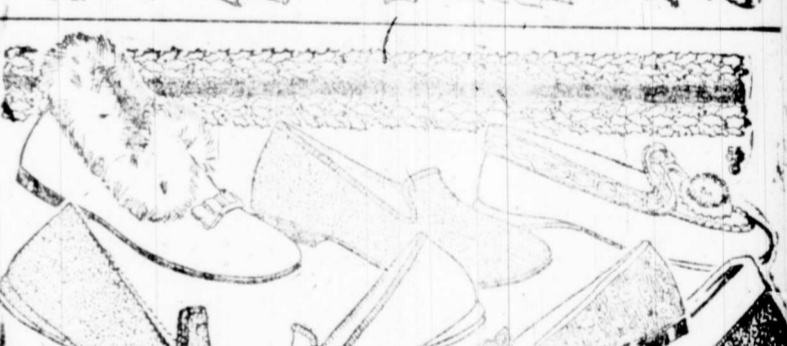
True Christmas Spirit. Exhibiting the true Christmas spirit, they forgot themselves and heartily gave thanks that the war which has saddened so many homes, has at last come to an honorable end for the Allies. Thankful they were that their pals with whom they had fought and who were now out of the trenches, many of them on their way home, should be able to enjoy the special services which had been prepared for Christmas Sunday. In addition to the special music, Holy Communion was observed in the Anglican churches of the city.

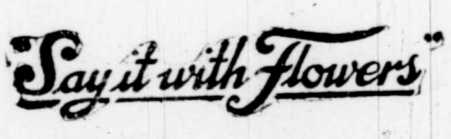
