Drilling is being done on the 500-foot level to pick up the Dominion's vein, which runs parallel to the main vein and assays \$4.00 per ton and will be of a much higher grade at depth. The drill is now at a depth of 1,000 feet incline. Work on the 900-foot level is satisfactory and a large tonnage of ore will be blocked out by the end of the year. The annual report should have greatly increased ore reserves over a year ago.
