

NOVA SCOTIA (89) ALMANACK.

COW-CABBAGE.—The seed of this extraordinary and invaluable plant, should be sown sparingly in drills, in a warm, sheltered situation; a square of 60 feet will contain 256 plants, 4 feet apart, these—the side shoots only being used—will serve 4 Cows for a year without the aid of other provender; open a sheaf of straw and bind carefully round the stem to preserve the roots in winter, or transplant with care into a cellar or green house—the shoots during winter make excellent greens. It grows tall and with a little attention will last for 4 years, when its stocks may be used for framing out houses, or perfectly dried will make good firewood.

FARMER'S WEATHER GUAGE.—Whenever you find the grass and plants free of dew, early in the morning, be sure that you will have rain before night; and govern your affairs accordingly.
