Petitions to the House of Commons.—It appears from the nineteenth report of the Committee on public petitions that the total number of petitions presented this session to the 17th June inclusive, was 4,460, of which number 459, with 370.706 signatures, were against the amendments of the House of Lords to the Irish Corporations Bill; 941 with 182.9464 signatures, in favor of the Lord's Day Bill; 3510 with 182.2976 signatures, for the abelition of ithes in Ireland; and 478 petitions, with 116.849 signatures for the repeal of the stamp duty en newspapets.
