V.) the coming anniversary, on the veritable battle ground of Beechlands, less than a mile from the town of Thorold; letters to the Minister of Militia, pleading for a portion of the fund appropriated to building monuments on the battle-fields of Canada; an application to the County Council for a grant of \$25 towards a library; deputations to search out and locate the exact site of the Battle of Beechwoods.
