MARITIMES WILL HAVE HEARING ON FREIGHT RATES

Ottawa, Sept. 18.—Light was shed upon the aims of the railways in the present rates battle over the application of the Crow's Nest Pass agreement when Eugene Lafleur, K. C., their leading counsel, declared this afternoon that he would endeavor to prove that the railway commission had jurisdiction over all questions of rates, including such agreements as the Crow's Nest Pass. He said he would challenge the accepted opinion that the jurisdiction of the commission did not cover this point. If he failed in this he would attempt to prove justification for the existing rate situation.

When all the evidence had been received this afternoon the hearing was adjourned until Monday morning when counsel will commence their arguments. Before the hearing adjourned R. E. Finn, who represents the Maritime

Provinces, declared the board had failed to notify the Government of New Brunswick. S. J. McLean, acting chairman, said he supposed notices had been sent only to the parties directly interested as plaintiffs or defendants. He promised Mr. Finn plenty of time in which to make good the lack of notice. The Maritime Provinces, from the evidence submitted, feel the discrimination in rates because the Crow's Nest Pass rate has brought about a marked decrease in westbound rates from Montreal, without lowering their transportation costs as well.

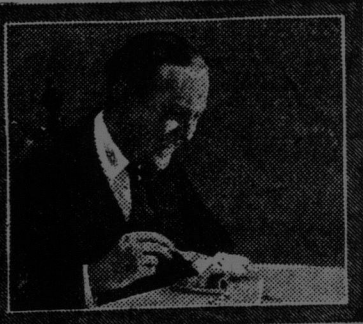

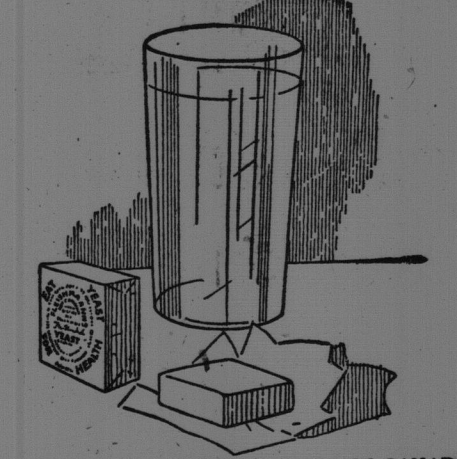
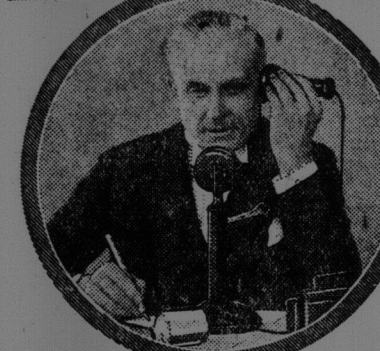
