Toronto, Dec. 29—Sir William Osler, Bart, M.D., F.R.S., F.R.C.P., was the most distinguished member of a remarkable family. Two brothers of Sir William Osler survive and reside in Toronto. They are Hon. Fetherstone Osler, president of the Toronto General Trusts are to St. Luke's hospital.

> Sir William's mother died some years ago at the great age of 101.
> Sir William Osler was born at Bond Head, a village near Toronto and at-tended school at Port Hope whence he went to Toronto University, transfer-ring to McGill in 1870. In 1874 he was appointed profesor of the institutes of medicine at McGill and was elected physician to the Montreal General Hospital in 1878 and immediately began to teach in its wards thus laying the foundation for his future success at Johns Hopkin Hospital. In 1889 he removed to Baltimore where he became professor of medicine in Johns Hopkin University and physician-in-chief to Johns Hopkin Hospital. In 1905 Dr. Osler was called to the Regius professorship of medicine at the University of Oxford and received the honor of knighthood on the corona-tion of King George V. During the war he rendered great services as an organ-izer and as a counsellor his experience, zeal and resourcefulness of mind were indispensable and made of him an im-

To the time of his death he was leading a concerted movement to bring British medical education to the highest plane of thoroughness.
