

CLANCY Reg. No. 14268, ex-S/Sgt. William Jerome Clancy, 79, died April 18, 1996, at Chilliwack, B.C. He was born October 19, 1916, at Hamilton, Ont., and joined the Force August 27, 1941, at Toronto. Upon completion of training at "Depot" Division, Clancy was posted to "F" Division, Sask., at North Battleford, Meadow Lake, Onion Lake, Wilkie, Regina and Prince Albert. On August 1, 1951, he was transferred to "E" Division, B.C., at Victoria, Vancouver, Penticton and Chilliwack, retiring April 29, 1967. Clancy was promoted to corporal May 1, 1953; sergeant May 1, 1958; staff sergeant May 1, 1962.

CLARK Reg. No. 14117, ex-S/Sgt. Frederick Runnals Clark, 77, died May 14, 1996, at Claresholm, Alta. He was born September 3, 1918, at Rosetown, Sask., and joined the Force May 1, 1941, at Regina. Upon completion of training at "Depot" Division, Clark was posted to "K" Division, Alta., at Lethbridge, Blairmore, Claresholm, Waterton Park, Calgary, Vulcan, Cardston, Medicine Hat and Coutts. On February 22, 1955, he was posted to "A" Division, Ont., at Sault Ste-Marie, North Bay and Ottawa, retiring February 22, 1965. Clark was promoted to corporal May 1, 1951; sergeant May 1, 1955; staff sergeant November 1, 1958. He subsequently served as Chief Constable of the Sault Ste-Marie Police until February 1, 1979.

The RCMP Commissioner's Commendation for Courage was awarded to ex-S/Sgt. Clark for his attempt to recover the body of an RCAF member which had gone over a waterfall at Claresholm, Alta.

COTTER Reg. No. O.619 (16548) Insp. John Leslie Cotter (retired), 77, died June 19, 1996, at Victoria, B.C. He was born October 24, 1918, at Winnipeg, Man., and joined the Force August 15, 1950, upon the amalgamation with the B.C. Provincial Police, where he had been serving since April 1948. Cotter was posted to "E" Division, B.C., at Burnaby and Vancouver. He was subsequently transferred to the following locations: October 16, 1957, to "F" Division, Sask., at Regina; October 22, 1963, to "A" Division, at Ottawa; November 1, 1965, to HQ; June 1, 1972, to "G" Division, N.W.T., as OIC Administration & Personnel at Yellowknife; June 20, 1974, to "E" Division, at Victoria, retiring December 30, 1975. Cotter was promoted to corporal May 1, 1955; sergeant May 1, 1957; staff sergeant May 1, 1959; sub-inspector December 8, 1966; inspector December 8, 1968.

CUNNINGS Reg. No. 13388, ex-Cst. Glenn Franklin Cunnings, 79, died December 22, 1995, at Kimberley, B.C. He was born August 2, 1916, at Kerrobert, Sask., and joined the Force April 20, 1940, at Regina. Upon completion of training at

"Depot" Division, Cunnings was posted to "D" Division, Man., at Carman and Winnipeg. On June 1, 1942, he was transferred to "G" Division, N.W.T., at Dawson, Fort Selkirk and Whitehorse, taking his discharge May 31, 1944.

DE BRUIN Reg. No. 22679, ex-Cpl. Arnold De Bruin, 56, died May 28, 1996, at Victoria, B.C. He was born May 20, 1940, at Birch River, Man., and joined the Force June 29, 1962, at Winnipeg. Upon completion of training at "Depot" Division, De Bruin was posted to "E" Division, B.C., at Kitimat, Prince Rupert, Ocean Falls, Burns Lake, Terrace, Princeton and Richmond. On September 13, 1971, he was transferred to HQ, then on June 25, 1973, he was posted to "E" Division, at Victoria, and retired July 22, 1983. De Bruin was promoted to corporal October 15, 1974.

EMERSON Reg. No. 12452, ex-Cst. Harold Cameron Emerson, 85, died May 29, 1996, at Port Coquitlam, B.C. He was born September 18, 1910, at Hamilton, Ont., and joined the Force November 13, 1934, at Ottawa. Upon completion of training at "Depot" Division, Emerson was posted to "F" Division, Sask., at Regina, Yorkton and Canora. On May 17, 1937, he was transferred to "A" Division, Ont., at Ottawa and Brockville. On October 22, 1938, he was posted to "N" Division and took his discharge November 12, 1939.

ENNALS Reg. No. 16421, ex-S/Sgt. Charles Edwin Ennals, 84, died March 29, 1996, at Duncan, B.C. He was born August 30, 1911, and joined the Force August 15, 1950, at Nanaimo, upon the amalgamation with the B.C. Provincial Police where he had served since 1942. Ennals was posted to "E" Division, B.C., and was subsequently transferred to the following locations: August 1, 1958, to "Depot" Division; November 1, 1960, to HQ; February 1, 1965, to "E" Division, and retired January 8, 1970. He was promoted to corporal May 1, 1952; sergeant November 1, 1958; staff-sergeant November 1, 1961. (Information provided by the RCMP Historical Branch. — Ed.)

FORD Reg. No. 20415, ex-Sgt. Wilbert Douglas Ford, 59, died April 20, 1996, at Toronto. He was born September 29, 1937, at Kilbride, Ont., and joined the Force April 8, 1958, at Toronto. Upon completion of training at "Depot" Division, Ford was posted to "A" Division, Ont., at Ottawa and Kingston. On June 29, 1978, he was transferred to "O" Division, at Toronto, and retired April 10, 1982. Ford was promoted to corporal April 1, 1968; sergeant May 1, 1973.
