of a large treatise on Special Pathology and Therapeutics and his text-book of the practice of medicine may be said to be a condensed edition of the author's great work. This work was written as a text-book for students, but we have no doubt that it will prove of the greatest service to practitioners as well. It differs from most other works of the kind in containing sections devoted to the Diseases of the Skin, Genito-Urinary Diseases, Impotence and Spermatorrhea. The English translation is presented in two volumes.

Volume I. is devoted to the consideration of diseases of the circulatory organs, respiratory organs, digestive organs, genitourinary organs and nervous system, while Volume II. has the following contents: Diseases of the nervous system (continued), muscles, skin, spleen and blood, disorders of metabolism and infectious diseases. A perusal of the work has convinced us that it is an excellent text-book for students. The illustrations are good, and the insertion of prescriptions in the parts of the articles devoted to treatment will be appreciated by both practitioners and students.
