## INTRODUCTION.

**H**IS Majesty having thought proper, to take into His Royal Consideration, the modes in which the *Manual* and *Platoon Exercises* are at present performed by his Troops ;—and it appearing to His Majesty, that some alterations might be made in both, which would be productive of great utility, and advantage to His Service ;—particularly, by reducing the unnecessary length of the former ;—His Majesty is therefore pleased, hereby to recall, and cancel His former Regulations, respecting the *Manual* and *Platoon Exercises*, and to order that, in their stead, the following shall be adopted, and invariably practised in future, by His whole Army.
