At the GENERAL ASSEMBLY of His Majesty's ISLAND of ST. JOHN, begun and holden at CHARLOTTE-TOWN, on the Eighth Day of October, ANNO DOMINI, one thousand ſeven hundred and ſeventy-nine, and in the nineteenth Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord GEORGE the Third, of GREAT BRITAIN, FRANCE and IRELAND, KING, Defender of the Faith, &c. and thence continued by Prorogation until the thirteenth day of March, one thouland ſeven hundred and Eighty, and in the Twentieth Year of His ſaid Majesty's Reign ; being the ſecond ſeſſion of the third General Aſſembly, convened in the ſaid Iſland.
