As part of the Project OTZMA team, you'll live, learn and work in virtually every part of Israel:

- You'll spend Three Months on a Kibbutz Ulpan, working for half a day and studying half a day. Classes, except those to teach you Hebrew, will be taught in English. One day a week you'll visit with a leading Israeli educator, politician, scientist, author or artist.
- You'll spend A Month and a Half Doing Agricultural Work ona Moshav (a private farm) in the Arava/Jordan Valley.
- You'll spend A Month and a Half to Two Months on a military base in the Tel Aviv area, giving you the opportunity to meet with your Israeli peers who are presently serving in the Army.
- You'll spend Two and a Half Months in Project Renewal Cities (for San Francisco it is Kiryat Shmona) helping with urban renovation, education and other public service projects.
- You'll spend A Month and a Half Working in Israel's Forests and Participating in Archaeological Digs. You'll explore the ecology of modern Israel—and probe into its past.
