

date of Sale, to date of payment, or a total amount of 65%, if paid by the 1st Proximo.

I may state that before Patent can issue, it will be necessary to pay this balance, and file the usual Statutory proof as to the performance of settlement duties upon the Lot. The payment should be made and papers filed, through the local Agent, Mr. A. Marcoux, of Pointe Bleue, P.Q. who will, if all is correct, requisition the Department for the issue of Patent.

As the Department has been advised in other correspondence that you are assigning the Lot, I might point out that all Transfers should be also filed in the Department, through the local Agent.
