

This is exhibit A in the deposition of Mary Miller taken before me this 15th day of March 1894. J. P. [unclear] Indian Affairs.

This is the last will and Testament of me Mary Miller, of the Township of Tuscarora in the County of Brant and Province of Ontario made this 10th day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety four.

I revoke all former Wills or other Testamentary Dispositions by me at any time heretofore made, and declare this to be my last Will and Testament.

I direct, all my just debts, funeral and testamentary expenses to be paid and satisfied by my executors hereinafter named, as soon as conveniently may be after my decease.

I give, devise, and bequeath, all my Real and Personal Estate which I may die possessed of or interested in, in the manner following, that is to say:

To my daughter Charlotte wife of Elias Thomas the sum of fifty dollars.

To my son Jacob that part of lot number thirty nine in the River Range in the said Township of Tuscarora containing about thirty two acres more or less he to pay to my daughter Charlotte the above bequest of fifty dollars.

To my daughter Mary wife of John E. Davis the north half of the north half of the south half of lot number twenty five in the fourth Concession of the said Township containing twenty five acres more or less.

To my son James Seymore the sum of one hundred dollars and my aged mare and her colt one year old next Spring.

To my son Thomas Alfred and my daughter Sarah Minnie the south of lot number twenty three, in the first concession of the said Township containing one hundred acres more or less.
