Sir,-

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 25th ultimo enclosing applications for the admission of Lawrence and Oliver George Stevenson to the Hibernia Industrial School.

In reply I beg to inform you that the admission of these two boys is approved.

It is noted that Lawrence is seventeen years of age. The Department considers that where an applicant for admission is within such a short period of the age limit for discharge he should not be recruited to a residential school. However, as this boy is at present in your school and the application for his admission states that he has had no previous education, the Department will consent to his remaining in the school up till the time he reaches the age limit.

You will be good enough to forward the application for the admission of George Johnstone as soon as it is completed.
