
Ottawa, April 11, 1918.

Sir,-

The Department is in receipt of a communication from Dan Little Axe, Teepe Ranch, Blackfoot Reserve, in which he states that two girls ran away from the Old Sun Boarding school and that when they were brought back their hair was clipped off. He also says that these girls ran away a second time and that they don't seem to get on very well at the school. He does not give the names of the girls he refers to.

The Department would like to have a report from you in regard to Dan Little Axe and also in regard to the two girls who ran away from the school.
