un Friday, 29th September, 1944, at 22.00

hours, in company with sgt. Johnston J., of this Unit. I proceeded to St. Feters Flein, Chent, where I saw RIA.F. Jeep No. R.A.F. 154930. It was stationary. Canadian soldian walked away from the vehicle. I went to the soldier whem I now know to be the accused, and told him who I was and asked if he had been driving the Jeep. We said, "Yes." I cautioned him and he said, "I drove an officer into Chent and parked my Jesp near the Cathedral. I thought this was my Jeep." His breath smelt of drink and he wa excited. I placed him in close Arrest. He began fighting furiously with sgt. Johnston. and myself, se restrained him with difficulty and conducted him to the Jeep to bring him to his H.Q. He struggled fiercely in the Jeep and attem ted to throw sgt. Johnston out of the vehicle. He shouted, " I am not coming with any cocksucking English bastards. " on arrival at this Headquarters I cautioned and charged him. at 2315 hours on the same day I gave him into the custody of a Canadian rovost mit in Chent 10 5 bush St 355. 84 9mg 3.3 Sept. 1944
