



WHEREAS, on the 21st day of June, 1943, No. A-600140 Gunner Walter Joseph Lockett, 3rd (NB) Coast Regiment, R.C.A., C.A. was tried by a District Court-Martial and sentenced to undergo detention for a period of one (1) year and to be put under stoppages of pay until he has made good the sum of \$106.30 in respect of the cost of apprehension and return to his corps.

I THEREFORE do now remit the balance of the period of detention so awarded the said Gunner Lockett, effective the 12th day of October, 1943.
