Councillors:—Mr. D. A. Watt, re-elected; Mr. A. D. Steele, re-elected; Mr. Thomas White, M.P., re-elected; Mr. W. G. Murray, re-elected; Mr. R. R. Grindley; and Hon. Donald A. Smith.

Mr. Lewis suggested that at every annual meeting certain of the retiring members of Council should be made ineligible for re-election by that meeting, so as to ensure the election of new persons, and the infusion of new ideas into the executive of the Association. The suggestion elicited remarks by several members and was referred to the Council for consideration.

After a vote of thanks to the Chairman and Scrutineers, the meeting was adjourned sine die.
